

RULES FOR THE WEARING & REPLACEMENT OF IDENTIFICATION BADGES & LANYARDS

ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A LANYARD WITH AN ID BADGE ATTACHED AROUND THEIR NECKS. Lanyards, badges and their protective covers are to be maintained in good order.

The following color code is in effect during the 2010-2011 school year:

Class of 2011.....Black Lanyard
Class of 2012.....Purple Lanyard
Class of 2013.....Orange Lanyard
Class of 2014.....Green Lanyard
Temporary Badges will change daily.

Students can obtain a temporary badge in the Media Center from 7:35 AM until 8:10 AM. The temporary badge is good for one day only and must be returned at the end of the school day (not before 2:10) or before school the next day. Badges can be returned in one of the following places:
the Main Office, the BRC, or the Media Center in the morning
the Main Office, the BRC, or Ms. Juhlin's Room (302) at the end of the day
or hand off to one of the bus hallway monitors at dismissal time.

Consequences for students who forget their badges will be as follows:

- First Offense - Warning Issued**
- Second Offense - Aftersession Assigned**
- Third Offense - Call to Parent & Assignment to the BRC**
- More than Three - In-house suspension**

Students who lose their badges and lanyards must purchase new ones for a replacement cost of \$4.00 for each set. The costs of individual items are: lanyard (\$1.25), ID guards (\$.50) and the badge alone (\$2.25). These items can be purchased in the Business Office during school hours.

Students are required to return the temporary lanyards and badges at the end of the school day or before school the next day. Students who fail to do so will be given aftersessions for a first offense, and for each offense thereafter, they will be given aftersessions and charged a fee of \$2.00.
