RE: Student Transportation

Dear Parents and Students;

We hope that you have enjoyed your summer vacation and have had the opportunity to rest, relax, and of course, recharge for our return to school.

As we prepare for the upcoming 2022–2023 school year, the Assistant Principals wanted to provide all families and students with information specific to all forms of transportation to ensure that BVT procedures are followed to maximize safety and minimize confusion.

Bus Transportation

Bus routes have been updated and are listed on the BVT website under the “*School Year Information*” tab. Scheduling will provide families with pick-up locations and times. Students should be at their bus stops at least 10 minutes before the scheduled pick-up times.

As a regional school district, pick-up locations and times are determined based on many variables. With that being said, we are unable to accommodate requests for individualized home pick-ups due to the increase in ridership times. We want to highlight that families need to be mindful of the first rider on the school bus, and with making additional requested stops, that ridership time increases in both the mornings and afternoons.

It is important to note that bus stop locations **change from year-to-year**, and are based on riders’ home locations. Additionally, families and students should be aware that bus stop locations may change periodically for the first several months of school due to changes in student enrollment. Families and students are encouraged to check the website periodically for bus route updates.

Student Drop-Off

All students receiving an alternate ride to school **must** be dropped-off at the fitness center, located on the south side of the building, next to the football field. Student drop-off is in single file, and vehicles may not use two lanes for the safety of the students. After a student is dropped-off, traffic flow moves to two lanes, which allows drives to go left or right onto Pleasant Street.

Parents are **not permitted** to drop off their teen in the bus lanes or parking areas as drop-offs in those areas as it creates safety concerns and has an impact on the traffic flow on Pleasant Street.

Student Pick-Up

All students being picked-up from school must be picked-up in the visitor lot, which is on the north side of the building, right side front. Parents may not park along the fitness center to wait for their students as it impacts student dismissal and traffic flow.

Student Drivers

Seniors who have submitted parking applications, have been notified of the procedure for picking up parking tags for individually assigned, specific parking spaces.

Juniors interested in parking on a part-time basis, will be provided parking information as parking becomes available for all eligible junior students.

It is important to highlight that all student drivers must adhere to the parking regulations.
